Dear Parents/Caregivers,

IMPETIGO (SCHOOL SORES)

We have a case of Impetigo (school sores) at school and we are asking all parents/caregivers to keep a close eye on your child(ren) to reduce the possibility of spreading infection.

Impetigo is a bacterial infection that presents a red blister which can ooze and get a crust (scab) on top. It often develops around the nose and mouth but can appear on any part of the body. It is spread by direct contact.

If you suspect your child may have impetigo, please take them to the Doctor. They are to be kept at home for 24 hours after treatment with antibiotics has started. When they return to school, please ensure that the sores are covered.
