### Lunch Orders

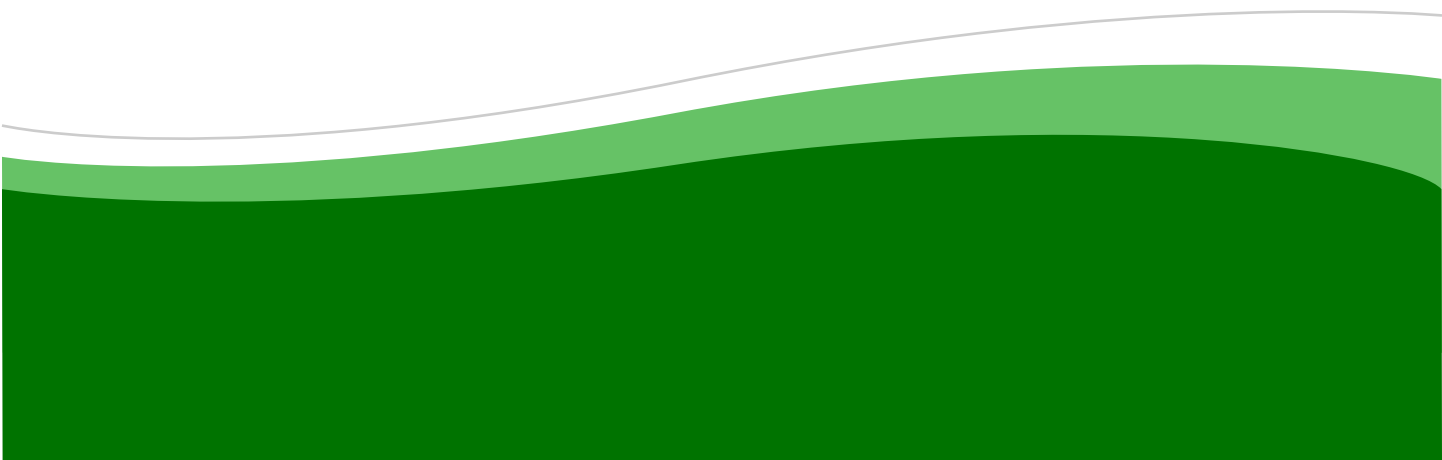
