WEDNESDAY 15 AUGUST – STRIKE REMINDER MESSAGE FROM THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

Dear Parents/Whanau

The New Zealand Educational Institute (NZEI) has advised the Board of Trustees that teachers and principals are taking full day strike action on Wednesday 15 August. As we will not have the resources to provide instruction or safe supervision, the Board has decided to close Greenpark School for the day, and buses will not be operating. Therefore, we need to ask all parents to make alternative arrangements for the care of their children on this day.

Although this is likely to cause inconvenience for a number of families, the Board is sympathetic to the issues being raised by our teachers and principals, which include teacher recruitment and retention, and the lack of learning support available to many of our children in need.

We hope that our wider school community also will show understanding and support.
